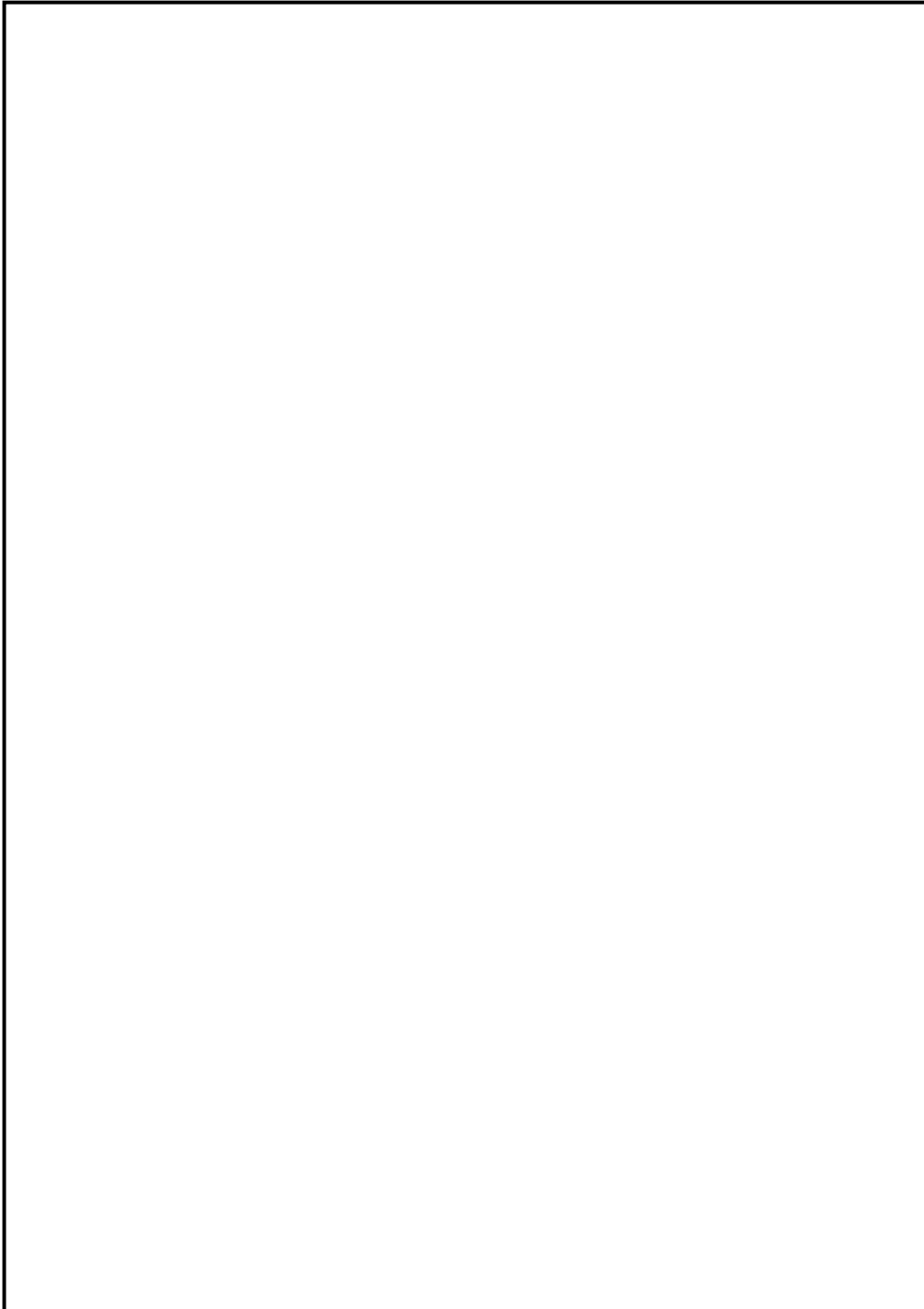
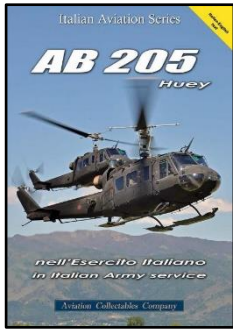

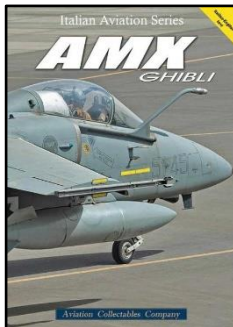


AB 205 Huey In Italian Army Service (Italian Aviation Series)

The very image of the helicopter, known by everyone, fans and non-experts. To anyone thinking of a helicopter, from the mid-fifties the 205 comes to mind. "The Huey" produced by Bell in the United States and under license, by Dornier in Germany, Agusta in Italy, AIDC in Taiwan and Fuji in Japan, more than 20,000 examples divided into a dozen of main versions with a myriad of variants and in service in more than seventy air forces over the past sixty years. Its fame originates from the extensive use by the United States Army during the Vietnam War, of which has become the symbol, as was the Jeep in World War II. The characteristic "Flap Flap" of the rotors, which announced their coming even before they are seen, gave the soldiers the certainty of the arrival of supplies, rescue or close air support.

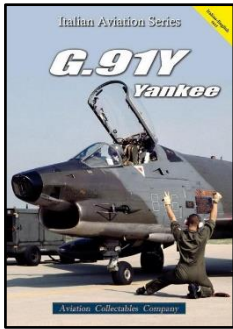


G.80/G.82 The First Italian Jet Trainer (Italian Aviation Series)

Only a few days to December 9th, that date is important because on that day, in 1951, it made the first flight G.80, the first Italian jet trainer. Although produced in Turin the historical flight happened to Amendola, military airport where the prototype was transported from Turin. The choice was obligatory because the Turin track was not long enough to guarantee operations with the new FIAT airplane. The history of the G.80, and of the subsequent improved version, the G.82, deserve to be known. The fifties, in Italy, were the pioneering times of the design of the first jets, the industries were trying to recover from the recent destruction of the war and were looking for markets to restart production. In this context the FIAT initiative, at the time led by prof. Valletta, who authorized Ing. Gabrielli to the project.

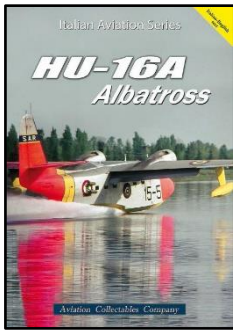


G.91Y Yankee

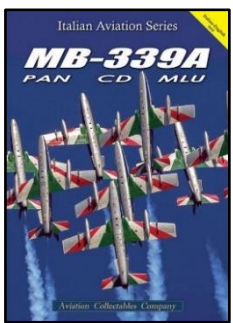


IL THUNDERJET IN ITALIA” continua il successo

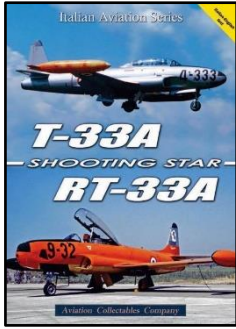

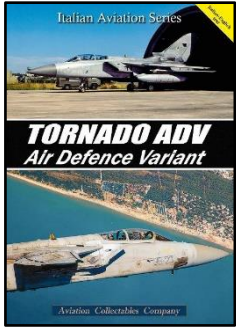

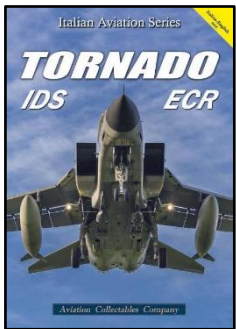
